

- -Founded by John Smith in 1666

- -Key in "War of 1812" British staging base
- -Bypassed during the American Civil War
- -Many slaves escaped here for sanctuary
- -By 1900, there were over 1,000 citizens
- -Largest church is the Swain UMC, est. 1835
- -Tradition of burying family in yards
- -Fishing/Tourism the main source of income
- -Airport was for med-evac, now helicopters
- -"Watermen" are the traditional fishermen
- -Today's population somewhere around 400
- -Economic/Environmental challenges
- -One school, police officer, post office + clinic
- -Daily ships deliver mail, food, supplies
- -Population is Christian, proud and patriotic
- -Predictions of environmental demise by 2060
- -Carlisle area churches coming to serve since 2015


My name is **John Osborn** a local General Contractor from Carlisle. I am serving as co-leader for construction projects on this trip. I am married to
